NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS A38 (TOYOTA ROUNDABOUT TO KINGSWAY ROUNDABOUT)

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential maintenance work to the A38, between the Toyota and Kingsway roundabouts. During this scheme we will:

- resurface both carriageways, some exit / entry slip roads and footways
- renew road marking and studs

Once our work is completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety and a smoother driving experience.

When will the work take place?

Work is due to start at the end of **September 2019** and is scheduled for completion by mid **December 2019**. To keep our programme for these works as short as possible we will work:

- between 8pm and 6am, Monday to Friday
- between 8pm and 6am over some weekends

To minimise disruption to the local community and road users, we will deliver our scheme in phases:

- **Phase 1:** we will work between Monday 23 September and Tuesday 15 October on the southbound carriageway from the Kingsway Roundabout to the A516
- **Phase 2:** we will work between Tuesday 15 October and Monday 4 November on the northbound carriageway from the A516 to the Kingsway Roundabout
- **Phase 3:** we will work between Monday 4 November and Wednesday 20 November on the northbound carriageway from the A50 to the A516

- **Phase 4:** we will work between Thursday 21 November and Wednesday 11 December on the southbound carriageway from the A516 to the A50

Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, sections of the A38 and adjoining exit and entry slip roads will be closed in phases while we work. All slip roads and both carriageways will be open as usual outside out working hours on weekdays. When we work over a weekend, a single lane closure will remain in place during the daytime.

During our overnight full carriageway closures, we will put in place fully signed diversion routes which will be agreed with the Local Authority. Please refer to the attached drawing for further detailed information.

How will the work affect pedestrians and cyclists?

We also need to close some sections of the footpath / cycleway along the A38 while we work. We will make alternative arrangements for pedestrians and cyclists, so they can continue their journeys safely. We will also make sure that all footpaths / cycleways are open as usual outside out working hours.

How will the work affect businesses and residents?


We will make sure that access to businesses and residences is maintained wherever possible.
